Greetings! Fall is around the corner and I pray that everyone will enjoy God's beautiful creation as the leaves change its colors. God is good!!

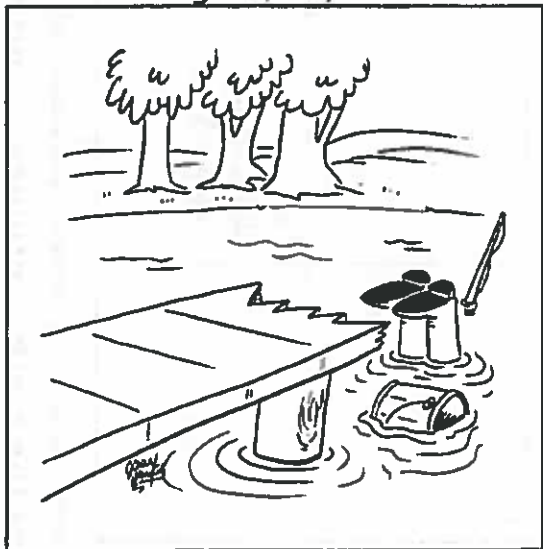
